**PIM-MAT 2020: Important –Notice**

All the candidates who have applied or want to apply for admission to MBA/MBA(Services Management) course (Session 2020-21) are hereby informed that:


- In view of present COVID-19 situation the **Exam date for PIM-MAT-2020 entrance test is hereby extended from 30<sup>th</sup> August 2020 to 15<sup>th</sup> September 2020.**
- The **last date for online submission of application form is also extended from 21<sup>st</sup> August 2020 to 05<sup>th</sup> September 2020.**

The PIM-MAT 2020 Admission Committee resolved the following in its meeting held on 25<sup>th</sup> August 2020 and approved by the Vice-Chancellor on 27/08/2020.

- Since the minimum eligibility for admission to MBA course is Bachelor's Degree in any discipline with at least 50% marks in the aggregate (without any approximation) and 45% in the aggregate in case of SC/ST/OBC(Non-Creamy Layer)/MBC. As Graduation result of the final year students of 2019-20 is not yet declared, it is not possible to move ahead with the admission process. Hence the committee recommended that the Exam date for PIM-MAT-2020 entrance test may be extended from 30<sup>th</sup> August 2020 to 15<sup>th</sup> September 2020 and the last date for submission of form (online) may also be extended from 21<sup>st</sup> August 2020 to 05<sup>th</sup> September 2020.
- If the present situation remains the same and there is no possibility to hold written exam, the admission process may be completed as per the following selection process (criteria and weightage) as recommended by the committee in its meeting held on 16<sup>th</sup> July 2020 and approved by the then Vice-Chancellor;

Marks obtained in Bachelor's Degree (Qualifying Exam)	40%
Marks obtained in Class XII	20%
Marks obtained in Class X	15%
Personal Interview	12.5 %
Group Discussion and Social Skills	12.5 %
<b>Total</b>	<b>100</b>

In lieu of PIMMAT written examination, merit of the applicants will be prepared on the basis of their marks obtained in class 10<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup> and graduation (on the basis of the weightage given above) and four times of the number of seats in each category the applicants will be called for GD and PI.
